Registration:

If possible, please register using Show Manager on the ILR Website. Go to the calendar of events on the ILR website and find "The Glacier Classic Llama Show", then click on Register for this Event. Follow instructions to submit entries and mail in payment, business card and/or sponsorship ad.

If you're not able to register online, download the show packet from the ILR Calendar. Please make sure you include all forms in your entries, payment and copies of ILR Registration Certificate for each animal.

Halter.

Ribbons will be awarded 1st-6th place with Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion awarded in the championship. Halter classes are \$30 for females, males, non-breeder, Get of Sire, Produce of Dam and Bred & Owned. Get of Sire consists of 3 animals from the same Sire (at least two different dams represented) and Produce of Dam consists of 2 animals from the same Dam. Production classes (Get of Sire and Produce of Dam) are judged on the parent's ability to pass on positive traits to their offspring. Bred & Owned is one animal that was bred by the exhibitor and also currently owned by the exhibitor.

Age Divisions:

Llamas-

Juvenile (5 months - <12 months)

Yearling (12 months - <24 months)

Adult (24 months & over)

Animals age on the day of the show is used to determine correct class.

Youth-

Sub Junior (under 7 years old)

Junior (7-11 years old)

Intermediate (12-14 years old)

Senior (15-19 years old)

Youth age divisions are determined by their age on January 1st 2025

Performance:

Ribbons will be awarded 1st-6th with Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion awarded to each Youth Division, Novice Division and Advanced Division. Performance classes are \$15 each for Novice, Advanced, Showmanship and Versatility class and \$10 each for youth classes. Versatility will combine the scores of Halter and all 3 Performance classes to find the highest scoring animal. Grand and Reserve Versatility Champions will be awarded to each division, youth and adult. Showmanship will take place before Halter on Sunday.

Fleece:

Ribbons will be awarded 1st-6th with Grand Champion and Reserve Champion awarded to each fleece division. Fleece classes are \$15 each for fleece on and shorn divisions. You may mail in fleeces to be entered to Susan Hannah c/o ILR at 11 ½ S. Meridian Kalispell, MT 59903. Please include a prepaid return label for shipping back after the conclusion of the show. Please check in your shorn fleeces upon arrival on Friday evening.

Vendor Booth:

Bring all your types of goodies to sell at the show! A vendor booth can be set up in the designated area inside the covered show arena and will be 12'x12' in size. Bring your own tables, tents and decorations for set up and your booth will be announced throughout the show! A vendor booth is \$50 for the whole weekend, you can start setting up 12pm on Friday. We're happy to have you!

Stalls:

The stall barn is found adjacent to the indoor show arena and houses some gorgeous 12'x12' stalls. Stalls are \$60 each for the weekend and straw will be provided on a first come first serve basis.
